BY-LAW NUMBER 2002- 0176 (REG-1)

BEING A BY-LAW RESPECTING THE
ISSUANCE OF GARAGE SALE PERMITS

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Georgina deems it advisable to require that a permit be obtained prior to conducting a garage/yard sale;

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF

THE TOWN OF GEORGINA:

1. For the purposes of this By-law:

Garage/Yard Sale means any sale in which second hand goods or materials are sold or displayed for the purpose of sale from any property zoned residential, rural, institutional, open space or transitional and included displays and sales in the following ways: Rummage Sale, Bazaar, Flea Market, Craft Sale, Yard Sale, Basement Sale, Garage Sale, Lawn Sale or other such similar events held for a maximum of three (3) consecutive days.

2. No person shall conduct a garage/yard sale without first having obtained a Permit.


3. Every person who obtains a permit for a garage/yard sale is entitled to a rain date provided it is held within one (1) month of the commencement date as outlined in the permit.

4. No person shall conduct more than three (3) garage/yard sales at the same location in a calendar year.

5. No owner or occupant shall permit more than three (3) garage/yard sales from the property owned or occupied by them in a calendar year.

6. A permit holder who erects signs in connection with the garage/yard sale shall remove the sign(s) within twenty-four (24) hours of the expiry of the permit.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 16th
day of December, 2002.
