



# Become a Town of Georgina Park Ambassador!

The Town of Georgina is seeking individuals to become official Volunteer Park Ambassadors for the Town of Georgina's parks and special events.

Park Ambassadors would act as "the eyes and ears of the community," working in a proactive manner to deal with crime prevention issues in Georgina. These Ambassadors will visit parks in their neighbourhood and would report back to the Recreation, Parks & Culture Department with concerns and suggestions and will be an ongoing presence in the community.

## Specific Duties:

- Attend mandatory training, provided by the Town of Georgina and York Regional Police.
- Direct all concerns to the appropriate municipal staff person by phone, e-mail or fax. (Or contact York Regional Police directly for emergencies).
- Provide advice to residents on how and who to contact for local issues.
- Be a good witness and report issues as they arise.
- Serve as a goodwill ambassador for the Municipality.
- Provide valuable information to friends & neighbours about municipal services.
- Participate in local municipal-sponsored events such as a Canada Day, SNO\*FEST, new park openings, etc.

## Participation Requirements:

- Must be a resident of Georgina.
- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- Must commit to be in their neighbourhood (minimum 1x per week/ year).
- Must attend an annual meeting to go over any updates to the program.
- Must receive a favourable clearance letter from York Regional Police (Clearance letter would be provided at no cost)
