Audit plan for the 2022 fiscal year

Council received the report regarding the audit plan for the 2022 fiscal year. Council also received the <u>presentation</u> and approved the audit plan prepared by KPMG LLP, Chartered Professional Accountants and Licensed Public Accountants, in consultation with Town staff. On Sept. 14, 2022 Council appointed KPMG LLP to provide audit services to the Town for the 2022 fiscal year.

Award of contact for Pump Track and Skate Park design and build

Council received the report regarding the award of contract for the pump track and skate park in Pefferlaw Park at 38 Pete's Lane and approved the award of contract to New Line Skateparks Inc. The Town will work with New Line Skateparks Inc. to ensure a variety of skill-level features are incorporated into the design to encourage people who are new to the sport or advanced to use this facility. Youth engagement is a critical component of this project. There will be online and in-person engagement opportunities this spring, with a focus on encouraging youth input on the design.

Bill 23 – the More Homes Built Faster Act

Council received the report regarding Bill 23, the More Homes Built Faster Act. Bill 23 is part of a suite of legislative initiatives advanced by the province supporting the Ontario Housing Supply Action Plan which seeks to increase housing supply in Ontario by building 1.5 million homes in the next 10 years. Many of the changes to legislation introduced by Bill 23 would have significant impacts on municipalities, reshaping the planning and development process in local communities. The bill effectively reduces the role of GTA regions and conservation authorities in the planning process, and would shift the responsibility for certain functions and costs to local municipalities. Town staff will continue to monitor Bill 23 and related legislation with consideration to its impacts on the Town of Georgina.
