Annual drinking water system summary reports for the Town of Georgina drinking water system
Council received the report for the Town of Georgina drinking water system and annual management review of the Town drinking water system. The Town received zero non-conformity and zero Best Management Practices (BMP) corrections resulting in an inspection rating of 100 per cent for the 2022 calendar year. This score indicates the highest possible inspection rating and the lowest possible risk rating for drinking water systems.

Update on the Town of Georgina feral cat trap, neuter and release program

Council received the report on the feral cat trap, neuter and release program (TNR), and approved the recommendation to transition it from a pilot project to a permanent program. The TNR program is the least controversial method of controlling the feral/stray cat population. Through it, cats are trapped, spayed or neutered by a veterinarian, and released back to their colony and/or placed for adoption when possible. It has been a success in Georgina and has played a vital role in controlling the feral cat/stray cat population. Council directed staff to arrange a meeting with the Feral Cat Committee and Promoting Animal Welfare Society of Georgina (P.A.W.S.) to discuss future funding for the program.
