Verbal report - Multi-use Recreation Complex (MURC) update

Council received the verbal report on the status of construction of the MURC. Progress continues on the siding and enclosing the building. The watertight tests of all three pools is now complete and tile installation has started. The interior glass curtain wall frames are being installed and the walking track railing is nearing completion. Landscape work has started with most curbs and planters complete. The project is on track for the MURC to be substantially complete in Q4 2023. Following turnover to the Town, there will be work to outfit with furniture and equipment, making the MURC ready to open to the public in Q1 2024.

York Region and the Town of Georgina continue their strong partnership to expand the active transportation network along Woodbine Avenue. After months of discussion, this collaboration will bring a new multi-use path to the west side of Woodbine Avenue, from Glenwoods Avenue to Garrett Styles Drive, completing a necessary active transportation connection to the Town's new Multi-use Recreation Complex. The detailed design is now underway with construction planned in 2024.

Bi-annual traffic control and parking request work plan update

Council received the report regarding the bi-annual traffic report and approved a change to By-law 2002-0046 (TR-1) – schedule XXVIII (speed limits) to include Black River Road between Park Road for 150 metres eastward, with a maximum rate of speed of 40Km/hr. Council also approved a change to the same by-law, schedule V (no stopping) to include the proposed 2023 bollard locations (10 metres on either side). Council approved the school zone traffic-calming standard and directed that York Regional Police be advised of the by-law revisions for speed limits.

Town of Georgina 2023-2027 Strategic Plan

Council received the report regarding Georgina's Game Plan, the 2023-2027 Corporate Strategic Plan, and endorsed the plan with amendments through Council discussion. The plan outlines the priorities for the organization, ensuring a common direction and objectives for Council and staff over the next four years. The strategic plan includes the collaborative input of more than 1,200 stakeholders, representing a diverse range of perspectives. Staff will be reporting annually on the implementation progress.

That Council receive the update from staff and that staff be directed to proceed accordingly.
