Town implements holiday parking relief

Cars to be removed during winter operations

Georgina, ON – Tis the season for celebrating with family and friends, and the Town is providing temporary relief to its on-street parking restrictions so residents and visitors don't have to move their car, except when winter operations are underway. This will be in effect from noon Friday, Dec. 22, 2023, to Tuesday, Jan. 2, 2024. Municipal Enforcement will not ticket vehicles parked for more than three consecutive hours or between 2 a.m. and 7 a.m. All other parking restrictions remain in effect.

This does not apply during winter maintenance events, including significant snowfalls and storms. The Town reminds residents to be aware of the weather and remove vehicles from the street so snowplows can safely do their job.

Other parking restrictions will continue to be enforced, including -

- No vehicle can be parked on or over any portion of a sidewalk or footpath.
- No vehicle can be parked on a grass boulevard.
- No vehicle can be parked on the paved boulevard section of the driveway with the vehicle overhanging any portion of the road.
- Areas where parking and/or stopping is prohibited by signage

Residents are also reminded to keep the area around fire hydrants clear and not to shovel snow onto the street. Regular winter parking restrictions will resume on Wednesday, Jan. 3, 2024 and will be in effect until Monday, April 15, 2024.
