Notice of Construction Pefferlaw Dam Rehabilitation

The Town is undertaking the rehabilitation of the Pefferlaw Dam and associated parkland. This work includes concrete repairs, armour stone retaining wall repairs, maintenance bridge replacement, soil remediation and site restoration. Construction is planned to start in September and be completed in December 2024.



What can you expect?

- Work hours: Work will take place between 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday to Friday, with occasional work after hours and on weekends as required.
- Water levels: Water levels upstream of the dam will be temporarily lowered for worker safety during construction. Water levels will return to normal seasonal levels in 2025.
- Park access: The Pefferlaw Dam and associated parkland will be closed for the duration of the project.
- Noise and dust: Due to the nature of the work, there will be construction-related noise and dust, though every effort to minimize this will be made.
- Restoration: The work area will be restored to existing conditions at completion of the work. There will be additional tree plantings as well.
