Notice of Road Closure and Investigations Old Shiloh Bridge Replacement

The Town of Georgina is beginning the preliminary design phase for replacement of the Old Shiloh Bridge. The existing single-lane arched bridge will be replaced by a two-lane bridge. During the period from October to December 2024, the Town's engineering consultant will be conducting field investigations to support design of the new bridge. The investigations include environmental surveys, legal and topographic surveys, and soils investigations. The bridge will be closed for 2 - 3 days in October 2024 to conduct soils investigations. The location of the bridge is shown in the figure below:



What can you expect?

- Investigation activities: Field staff will be conducting investigations on the road, bridge, and surrounding areas within the Town's right-of-way.
- Investigations timeline: Investigations are expected to occur in the period from October and December 2024.
- Bridge closure: The bridge will be closed for 2-3 consecutive days during October 2024. Advanced signage will be posted to confirm the exact dates. Access for emergency services will be maintained.
- Construction timeline: Construction is expected to commence in late 2025. There will be further notices once the project is closer to the construction date.
