

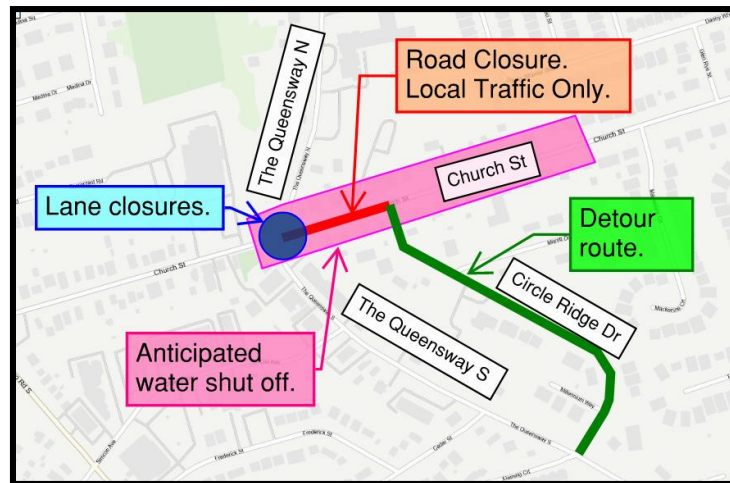

Notice of Lane Closures and Temporary Water Shut-Off Valve Chamber Upgrades

The Town is increasing the water pressure for users of the drinking water system in the Woodbine Avenue, Church Street, The Queensway North, and Morton Avenue area. This work involves upgrading and installing new valves on the water system. One valve is located at the Church Street and The Queensway North intersection and will require temporary water shut-off, and road and lane closures as shown below.



What can you expect?

- Road access: Church Street between The Queensway North and Circle Ridge Drive will be closed for approximately 1 week starting November 11 or 12, 2024. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.
- Water service disruptions: The water supply to properties in the zone indicated on the figure may need to be temporarily shut-off to complete construction. If this becomes necessary the contractor will provide 48 hours advance notice.
- Work hours: Work will take place between 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday to Friday, with potential work after hours and on weekends as required.
- Noise and dust: Due to the nature of the work, there will be construction-related noise and dust, though every effort to mitigate disturbances.
