RE: Upcoming inspection and survey work

Dear resident/occupant,

The Town of Georgina is pleased to announce the initiation of a project to enhance the streetscape and upgrade the infrastructure along a section of High Street in downtown Sutton. This initiative is part of our ongoing efforts to beautify the area and improve the functionality and appearance of the downtown Business Improvement Area (BIA).



This project focuses on two main objectives:

1. Streetscape improvements: Enhancing the aesthetic appeal and commercial attractiveness of High Street through modern streetscaping.
2. Infrastructure upgrades: Upgrading the road, stormwater and water supply systems to meet current standards, ensuring reliable and efficient services for years to come.

The Town has engaged CIMA Canada Inc. (CIMA+) as the engineering consultant to lead the design phase of this project. The design work is expected to be completed by 2025.

Survey work:

As part of the design process, CIMA+'s survey team will be conducting field inspections and site surveys along High Street. These activities may require access to areas on or adjacent to your property for measurement purposes only. No other disruption is expected as part of this work.

Scheduled dates:

Survey and inspection work is planned to occur the week of Sept. 30, weather permitting. We appreciate your cooperation and understanding as we work to improve our community.
