RE: Upcoming temporary lane closure for engineering investigation

Dear resident/occupant,

The Town of Georgina is undertaking a project to enhance the streetscape and upgrade infrastructure along a section of High Street in downtown Sutton. This initiative is part of our ongoing efforts to beautify the area and increase commercial attraction of the Business Improvement Area (BIA).



This project focuses on two main objectives:

- 1. Streetscape improvements: Enhancing the aesthetic appeal and commercial attractiveness of High Street through modern streetscaping.
- 2. Infrastructure upgrades: Upgrading the road, stormwater and water supply systems to meet current standards, ensuring reliable and efficient services for years to come.

The Town has engaged CIMA Canada Inc. (CIMA+) as the engineering consultant to lead the design phase of this project. The design phase of the project is expected to span most of 2025.

As part of the design process, CIMA+'s team will be conducting a geotechnical investigation along High Street in this area. A single lane on High Street will be temporarily closed the week of Dec. 16, weather permitting, to accommodate drilling equipment and personnel. Two-way traffic and pedestrian traffic will be maintained for the entire duration of the lane closure.
