The successful candidate will work as part of a dynamic team, possess a high level of professionalism, demonstrated problem-solving skills and exceptional verbal and written communication skills.

General Volunteer Firefighter Duties:

Volunteer firefighters are responsible for a variety of duties including, but not limited to the following:

- Responding to various incidents including, fire, rescue and medical emergencies;
- Performing manual work of a hazardous nature involving fighting fires, salvaging, rescue work and administering first aid under direct supervision;
- Participating in regular training

Applicants must possess the following minimum qualifications:

- Must be able to work in a highly structured work environment and follow rules, regulations and the procedures of the Georgina Fire Department.
- Must possess and maintain the physical strength and agility to perform arduous work and to competently operate all fire fighting/rescue apparatus and equipment and all safety equipment under all types of adverse conditions frequently for prolonged periods of time.
- Must have the ability to follow direction, make decisions and to react calmly and quickly in emergency situations.
- Must be at least 18 years of age.

- Excellent communications skills, both written and verbal.
- Must have no criminal record unless a pardon has been granted under the *Criminal Record Act of Canada* and has not been revoked.
- Must possess a valid Ontario driver's licence class "G" in good standing. Successful candidates will be required to obtain their "DZ" licence within the first year of employment at their own expense.
- Have prescribed 20/30 uncorrected vision in each eye without corrective lenses, with color vision, depth perception and peripheral vision that is safe for Firefighters (York University Fitness/Medical Testing).
- Have prescribed normal unaided hearing hearing thresholds no greater than 30 decibels in each ear at 500 Hz, 1000 Hz and 2000 Hz, and no significant loss in higher frequencies (York University Fitness/Swim/Medical Testing).
- Pre-Service Fire Fighting Certificate and/or NFPA Level I and Level II Certification and 472 HazMat Certification is not required but preferred.
- Availability to attend emergency calls during days, nights, weekends and statutory holidays. Ability to work extended hours when required as a result of emergency responses.
- Available to regularly attend scheduled training events which may be scheduled during weekends.
