Town to begin ice refrigeration upgrade project at Georgina Ice Palace

Georgina, ON – The Town of Georgina is set to begin a significant ice refrigeration upgrade project at the Georgina Ice Palace, with limited spring ice access starting April 28, 2025. This project will address essential improvements to the facility's refrigeration units to improve overall reliability and operational efficiency.

The Town is working with sports organizations and rental groups to support their seasonal ice needs. To accommodate spring ice users, the Sutton Arena will remain open through late spring, allowing youth groups to finish their seasons.

Ice will be unavailable at all Town locations starting May 18, 2025 and will resume on Sept. 2, 2025 at the Georgina Ice Palace and on Sept. 15, 2025 at the Georgina Sutton Arena.

This much-anticipated improvement reflects the Town's dedication to supporting healthy lifestyles and ensuring community spaces meet evolving needs.

The Town appreciates the patience and understanding of the community during this transition and looks forward to welcoming everyone back to the improved Georgina Ice Palace this fall.
