Upcoming project workshops High Street Streetscape and Infrastructure Improvements

The Town of Georgina is undertaking a project to enhance the streetscape and upgrade infrastructure along a section of High Street in Sutton. This initiative is part of efforts to beautify the area and increase activity in the downtown core. The Town is organizing meetings with key stakeholder groups to review and discuss design ideas for planned improvements along High Street. An important part of this discussion will focus on understanding resident and business concerns about disruption due to construction and exploring ideas to minimize those impacts. Key stakeholder groups will be invited to participate in the following meetings in late February and early March.

- Meeting #1: Sutton BIA, High Street business owners and High Street residents
- Meeting #2: Public service providers and regulatory agencies
- Meeting #3: Georgina Advisory Committees

Each meeting will start with a presentation followed by open discussion and questions about the project. Participants will be invited to share their thoughts on opportunities and impacts specific to their residence or business. Main topics to be covered in the presentation include:

- An overview of the project, its goals and timeline
- Different design ideas being considered
- Plans to minimize disruptions to businesses and the community
- Discussion of preferred design concepts

Individual invitations will be sent to stakeholders directly for each meeting.

A public, project specific Open House focused on sharing information on design and streetscape concepts from the pre-design and stakeholder workshops will follow in Spring 2025 – details to follow.
