## INTRODUCTION

Mann Cemetery is located on Lot 17, Concession 3, in the Town of Georgina, formerly North Gwillimbury Township. It is on the west side of North Queensway, north of Old Homestead Road in Keswick, Ontario.

This cemetery was originally the Christian Church Burial Grounds, also known as Sprague Cemetery. In 1820 David Sprague bought 200 acres of land from Isaac Willcocks, and in 1831 he sold 100 acres to Richard Mann.

This cemetery has not been active for many years and is now maintained by the Town of Georgina.

The earliest burial recorded in this cemetery is Darius Mann, Sr. who died in 1826, aged 53 years old. The most recent burial is of Permillia Thompson, wife of James Morton, who died March 17, 1929, aged 75 years, 3 months.

This transcription is part of an ongoing project of the Ontario Genealogical Society to record all the gravemarkers in Ontario. The cemetery was transcribed in 1973 by W. E. Britnell and again in 1991 by Carole Carruthers, Harry Carruthers, Ruth Cooke, Helen Cuthbertson, Robert Heron, Norman Jolley, Marilyn Lawson, Nancy Lynn, Natalie Nixon, Betty Prosser, Ann Rogers, Lori Slater and Elaine Wedlock. The map was prepared by George Cuthbertson and Jeff Bender. Helen Cuthbertson took the photographs and compiled the introduction and Cathy Hamilton entered the material into computer.

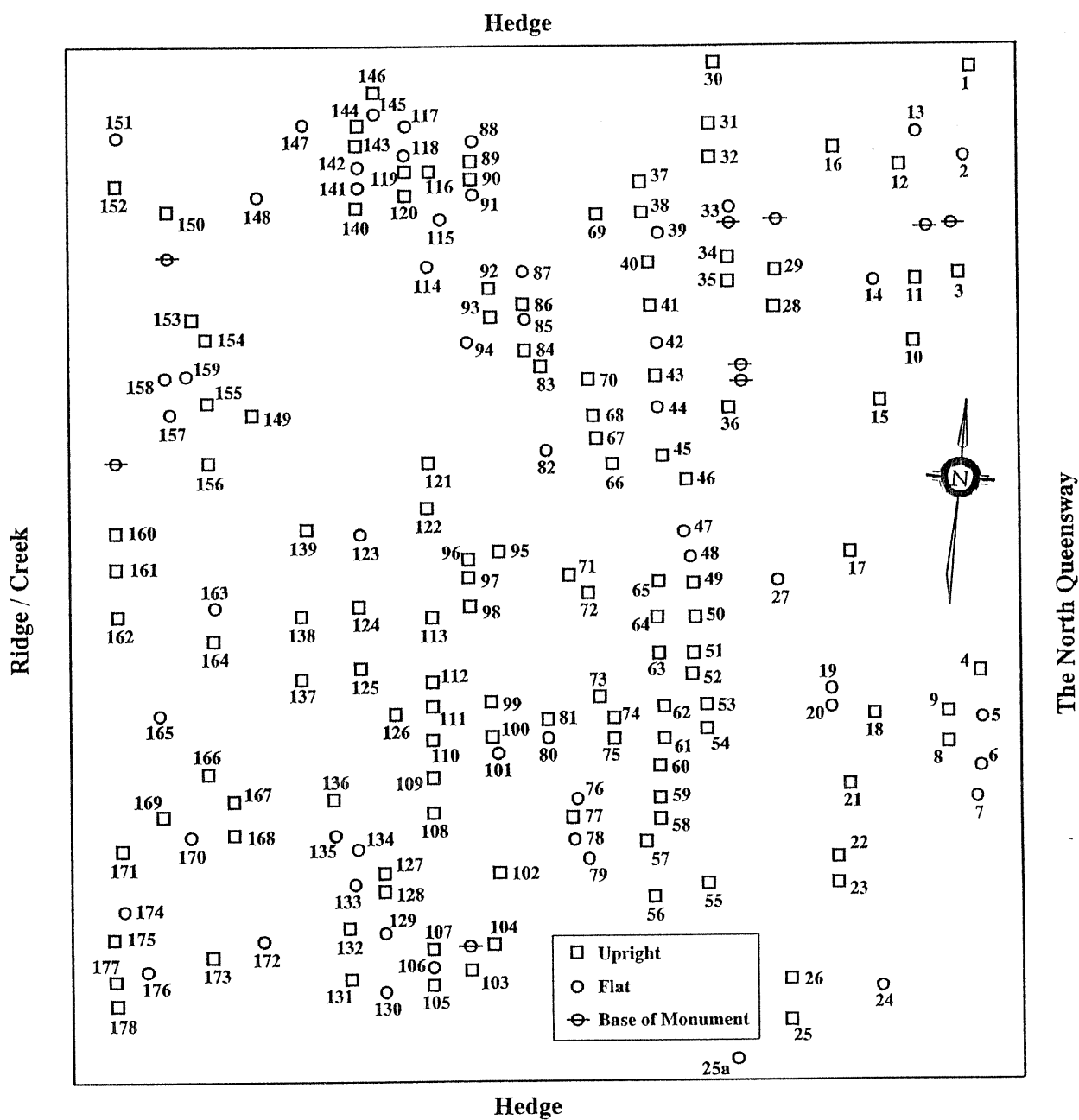
