The Lake Simcoe Region Conservation Authority advises that the Weather Office is forecasting rainfall amounts in the range of 25 – 50 mm are predicted within the watershed on Sunday evening through Monday afternoon.

As a result of this predicted rainfall, minor flooding may occur in low lying areas. The forecasted rainfall will result in higher flows in all our rivers and streams, resulting in dangerous flow conditions. All watercourses in our area may experience higher than normal water levels. As a result, local streams and rivers will become dangerous, especially in the vicinity of culverts and bridges. Children should be warned to stay away from all watercourses.

This Watershed Conditions Statement will be in effect through Tuesday, March 29th, 2016.
