SUBJECT: AWARD OF CONTRACT - CAO2018-064

CONSTRUCTION OF PEFFERLAW FIRE STATION

1. RECOMMENDATION:

- 1. That Council receive Report No. ES-2018-0003 prepared by the Emergency Services Department dated June 20, 2018 respecting the award of contract CAO2018-064-Construction of Pefferlaw Fire Station.
- 2. That Council approves and authorizes the Purchasing Agent to enter into a contract with BECC Construction Group Ltd. for the purpose of constructing the Pefferlaw Fire Station.

2. PURPOSE:

This report is to seek Council approval for the awarding of Contract CAO2018-064 for construction of the Pefferlaw Fire Station.

3. BACKGROUND:

A Request for Prequalification (RFP) FES2018-015 was issued on February 6, 2018. The RFP was issued for the purpose of prequalifying potential bidders with the skills to complete the construction of the fire station. Twenty-seven (27) submissions were received and were evaluated by senior staff. On May 9, 2018 the Request for Tender (RFT) CAO2018-064 was issued to eight qualified construction firms. Six submissions were received and two, no-bid submission was also received. The low bidder was BECC Construction Group Ltd.

4. ANALYSIS:

BECC Construction Group Ltd. has constructed several fire stations within the province, with the most recently built fire station in Vaughan. Staff are looking forward to working with this construction company.
